

The aim of this sun safety policy is to protect children and adults from damage caused by the effects of ultraviolet radiation from the sun. The main elements of this policy are:

- a) Protection: providing an environment that enables children and adults to be safe on court. Shade will be available in the Clubhouse.
- b) Education: learning about sun safety to increase knowledge and influence behaviour. Sun safety will be included as part of the safety talk given at spring and summer tennis camps.
- c) Partnership: working with parents/carers, to reinforce awareness about sun safety. Information about sun safety will be included on tennis camp leaflets.

As part of the Sun Safety Policy we will:

- Encourage all players to wear a hat in sunny weather
- Encourage the use of sun creams. The Welfare Officer will ensure that Factor 50 sun cream is available for use by junior members and it will be kept in the Clubhouse.
- Encourage players to have water available during play
